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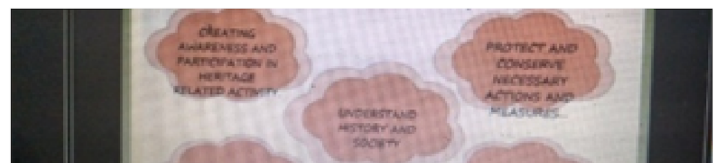
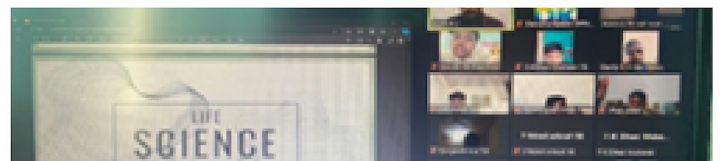
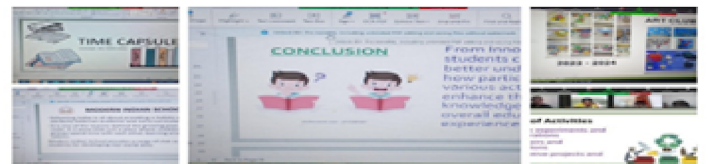
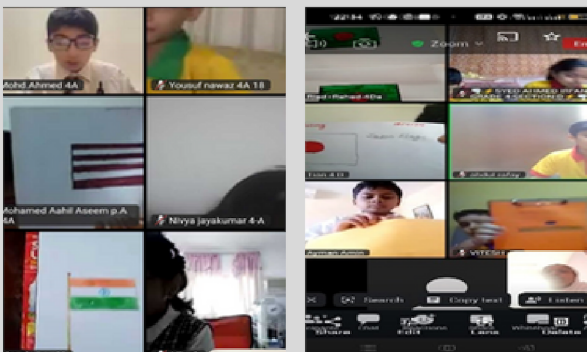
ORIENTATION ON PERSONAL HYGIENE

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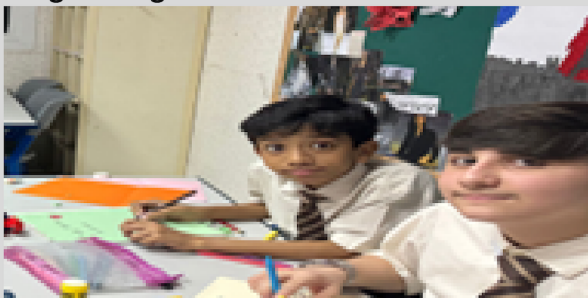


EARTH DAY CELEBRATION

PARENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

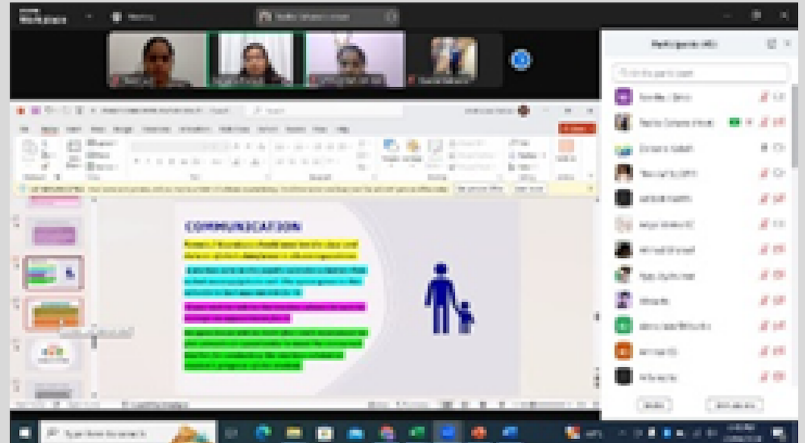
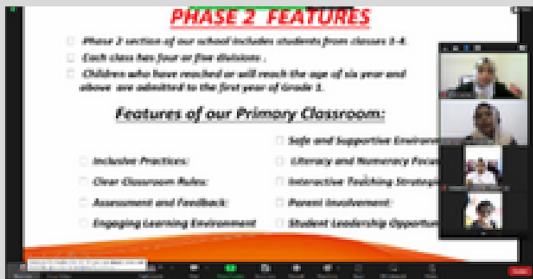
